### Greenwich

Only 11 minutes' drive from Kidbrooke Village and you can immerse yourself in the very heart of the historic Royal Borough of Greenwich. As an area with an unrivalled maritime heritage, it is home to cultural institutions like the Royal Observatory, Cutty Sark and National Maritime Museum. Attracting all and sundry to its glorious hillside park, there is also the covered market and an array of eateries to peruse at your leisure.

### North Greenwich

.....

On a prominent spur of the River Thames lies the main attraction of North Greenwich - the O2 Arena. A venue guite unlike any other, 'the O2' is a monument to entertainment and plays host to concerts, sporting events and exhibitions as well as popular restaurants, bars and pubs. Nearby, you can experience the jaw-dropping Emirates Air Line – a cable car connecting the Greenwich peninsula with the northern banks of the River Thames - and stay on-trend at the soon-to-beopened designer outlet centre.

#### Eltham

.....

A hidden gem amidst its better-known peers, the district of Eltham offers something for the curious. Home to the Plantagenet royal family from the 12th to 14th centuries, what remains of Eltham Palace was completely refashioned by the wealthy Courtauld family in the 1930s. The borough is also blessed with a strong sporting tradition. The Royal Blackheath Golf Club - widely renowned as the world's oldest course - is located here as well as Blackheath Rugby Club, which was the first open club of its kind.

### London Bridge

.....

London Bridge is a major transport hub for the Square Mile, surrounded by famous London landmarks. From the towering glass edifice of The Shard to the mouthwatering aromas of Borough Market, what better place to find yourself after a short ride.



#### **Closely Connected**

.....

Safe pedestrian and cycle routes run through and from the village, along with local buses running in every direction. Kidbrooke Village is just a short ride from Central London with direct trains leaving Kidbrooke Station for London Bridge, Waterloo East, Charing Cross and Victoria. From here, London Underground connections reach out across the city.




